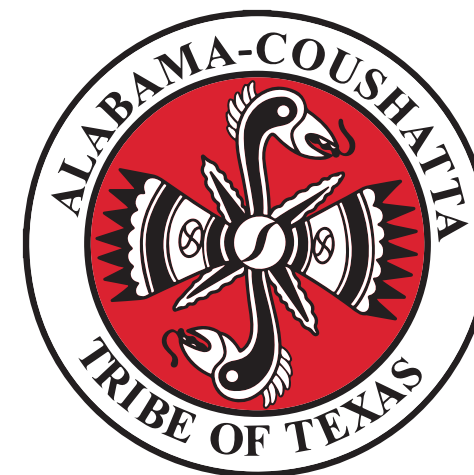

This past January, U.S. Representative Brian Babin (R-TX) introduced H.R. 759, known as the Ysleta del Sur Pueblo and Alabama-Coushatta Tribes of Texas Equal and Fair Opportunity Settlement Act. The passage of H.R. 759 will clarify the Tribes' sovereign rights to game and will also end the decades of litigation between the Tribes and the State of Texas.

The Tribe has received letters and Resolutions of Support from prominent community leaders, counties, Judges, Mayors and business leaders throughout Deep-East Texas - all of whom fully understand the positive economic impact of Tribal business in the region.

The Texas Forest Country Partnership commissioned an independent economic study on the impact of Naskila Gaming. That study found the following:

- In addition to the 370 jobs at Naskila, an additional 211 jobs have been created in Polk county because of Naskila;
- Naskila is responsible for infusing nearly \$140 million into the local economy;
- 95% of Naskila customers come from outside of Polk County;
- Without Naskila, none of these jobs nor any of this economic stimulus would exist.
